

PUBLIC WATER SYSTEM TESTING AND OPERATIONAL SERVICES

Licensed Operators—State Certified Laboratory

A number of levels of operating service are available. We will furnish and supply all of the chemical treatments required and mix chemicals for proper application strength, test chlorine levels at various sample points in the distribution system to insure sufficient levels for complete disinfection and perform all bacteria testing as specified by the DNR

Samples will be taken on the frequency determined by the DNR and tested in our State Certified Laboratory or by the appropriate state laboratory facility. Routine maintenance of all Water Technology of the Ozarks' owned equipment will be performed to insure peak operating efficiency, and Client will be advised if and "Client owned" equipment needs service.



Meter Reading And Billing Service

Water Technology of the Ozarks offers a meter reading and billing service. Monthly water bills are produced by computer from information downloaded from a palm pilot, which contains the water meter readings obtained by the meter reader. The amounts for the water used are automatically calculated and cards are printed and mailed to the customer. This program can be customized to meet the water system's requirements.
